3d printing combined with Yakisugi. Just hammer in the 3d print to the soft wood evenly and burn.

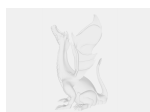

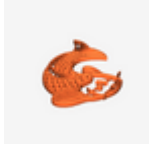
