Printed here in SpiderMaker matte PLA "wasabi", it reminds me a bit of the color of matcha green tea. I printed it face down on a textured PEI sheet.

No supports.

I glued it to a cork circle cut to the size, it had self-adhesive. I put sawdust in the openings so dirt and dust wouldn't stick in them.
