### Summary

I spilled most of a bottle of ink. I'm not doing that again, thanks to this. Fits Diamine's standard 30ml bottles.

Diamine makes some great and affordable fountain pen ink, but their bottles are very easy to tip over. You can avoid my mistakes with this print.

There are two versions of this model: One has cutouts for a TPU "foot" to keep it in place (ink-holder-with-foot-cutout.stl and foot-ring-tpu.stl) and the other with no foot cutout (ink-holder-no-foot-cutout.stl). If you print the second version, I recommend adding some small rubber feet or something else grippy to the bottom.

No supports required! Some small bridging occurs for the version with the foot cutout, but as long as your bridging occurs at 45 deg, there shouldn't be any long bridges.

In the photo, ignore the missing line in the middle of the print – that's a problem with my printer, not the model!
