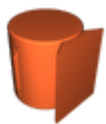

Post-Printing

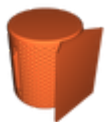
After printing, first break out the outer built-in support structure covering the door. With the door exposed, press on it gently at the edges to break it free of the sides. Then start sliding the door up and down, working it until it moves freely. Once you've got it slid all the way open, break out the inner built-in support.
