This is a card case that I originally designed for storing my rare Cards Against Humanity packs, but can be used for just about any card game. It is designed to hold cards stored in [these plastic bags](#), though that part is optional. The models have hidden spaces for embedded magnets (**20mm x 6mm x 2mm**) that can be added during the print so that the lid attaches to the case magnetically - who doesn't love magnets? The files already have the pause commands added to them. The final touch is that there is also a window on each end to include some display cards. It is sized to fit [these card sleeves](#).
