A copy of the Red Army's pre/early war cases for soap, tooth powder and tooth brush. Originally made out of celluloid plastic in a surprising variety of colours, both of solid and marbled varieties. The kits were produced in a smaller and a larger size, likely soldier's/officer's, where this is the smaller kit. The models are somewhat approximate and based on online photos and measurements of the originals.

Soap Dish: 65x47x24 mm

Tooth Powder Box: 47x47x24 mm

Toothbrush Case: 115x24x14 mm

They require some post-processing to look their best. My recommended method of printing for actual use is with the flat sides facing down (stars separated, see 3mf) using build plate supports to aid the fillets. Use as fine layer height as you have the patience for.

Designed for a 0.4mm nozzle


