This enables the Prusa Reception Tiles to go around a corner. Drywall walls usually aren't perfectly square, and the back corner is rounded to accommodate this.

If your printer's in good shape, these can look great with .3 mm layer height, 1 perimeter, and 2% infill. I used a little support though to be on the safe side, this model is tall and has very little contact with the print bed.

It looks strange in the 3d viewer because the viewer includes the negative volumes, which I used to remove corners.
