A shelf just big enough for a Synology mesh router, model MR2200ac, from which the router can't be removed unless the shelf is first removed from the wall. This ensures that the router can't fall off.

Here's how it's done:

1. Print the bracket with supports.
2. Break the supports off.
3. Insert the router in the bracket, routing your cable(s) to avoid pinching.
4. Screw the bracket to the wall.
