I saw a puzzle like this a very long time ago, and have recreated it here (but with a unique look). Easy to print!

The pieces are very loose within the frame. you need to position the piece's so that they interlock, and the puzzle can be moved about, with no loose parts!

This puzzle has six parts, the piece's (5) and the frame (1).

Print the frame:

I printed the frame with Inland Black Pla/PLA+ and Inland Silk Silver. The included print file has a built in pause for changing the filament for the trim around the frame.

Printing the pieces:

I printed the pieces with Inland Silk Silver, the included print file includes all five parts needed. I have also included separate stl files as well if you wish to slice your own.

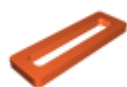
