I took Painttube Squeezer by joscho42, separated each component into a separate file, and in the slicer stretched the key and the frame just in X, leaving Y and Z alone, to fit my needs.

The 80mm slots became 120mm slots. The .3mf file from PrusaSlicer is included here.

The detachable ratchet wheel is a feature: it prints stronger in the current orientation, stays on in use, and is easy to remove when it comes time to unwind the squeezer to remove the old sour cream tube at the end of its life.
