.4 nozzle with .4 wall thickness, 3 wall count, no infill or supports

Use a brim for good bed adhesion.

PLA works fine. Sand it smooth and apply some spray shellac for a silky finish.

Post-Printing

The rocker extension is super glued to the original switch. For a strong bond scuff the switch with sandpaper before gluing. The ridge on the bottom of the extension aligns with the notch on the original switch.
