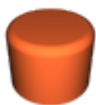
Notes:

I used white Ninjabflex TPE filament at 245C, printing at 10 mm/sec. It has just the right amount of "give". Not too soft and not too hard.

How I Designed This**123D Design**

I modeled this in 123D Design using only primitive shapes. A lip was included on the end so it would snap in place like the original one did. No adhesives required.
