Perfect to use when your wizard casts Enlarge, but you don't have a upscaled miniature at the ready. I included two types for Tiny creatures, since both 2/3 inch and 1 inch bases are commonly used for Small creatures.

The files included are:

- Tiny (0,5 inch) to Small (0,66 inch)
- Tiny (0,5 inch) to Medium (1 inch)
- Small (0,66 inch) to Medium (1 inch)
- Medium (1 inch) to Large (2 inch)
- Large (2 inch) to Huge (3 inch)

- Huge (3 inch) to Gargantuan (4 inch)

Large to Huge and Huge to Gargantuan bases are 1.75mm tall instead of 2.25mm, to print them at the same thickness as the smaller bases, print at 130%.
