remixed to remove the excess space allowed when pushing the part through another object. Glue this on and it fits ok.

I've found with this it's best to have hooks on 2 rows if you can to stop objects tilting as the hook isn't very long. Alternatively a longer model will sit well enough on the hook(s) if it's hangs against the pegboard.

Ideally I'd remodel it to extend down and have a nodule to sit in the next row like Ikea does with its hooks :)

As a tip for aligning multiple hooks I suggest push into pegboard (but don't move it down the slot) and then lay the item on to be glued. Superglue has been effective and fast :). Just don't put too much on and have it spread onto the pegboard as well :P.

I have a scrap of old pegboard I use for this and designing parts.
