Do you live in absolute filth? Does the state of your pantry walk a fine line between something you're just quietly ashamed of, and a genuine hazard to your families health? Mine too!

This model takes you just one tiny step further away from the hospital emergency department by making sure that your assortment of ant-ridden and expired Sodastream syrup bottles sit in straight, orderly lines, rather than being generally strewn about on random shelves. This creates a vague illusion of organisation, without actually fixing the root of the problem. Look at you go!

The corners are cut out, so you can even print this on your outdated ender 3 with a 200x200 build area. Just make sure to rotate it 45 degrees, then it will fit nicely.

Spacing is uniform between the broad and short edges, so you can make a larger grid simply by printing multiple and butting them up against each other.
