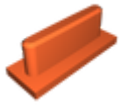
Many Fitbit Charge 5 suffers from tracker falling off users wrist unexpectedly. This is caused by the locking latch that suppose to keep the band locked. See several user reports and Fitbit answer [here](#).

For me none of the suggestions worked. I determined that the problem must be the “fingernail hook” that is too high and causes it to catch the skin and open the latch when not desired.

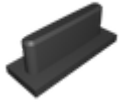
This 3D model will hold the latch open and the “fingernail hook” off the tracker body. This allows using a small needle file and file the hook lower.

I have been using the tracker for 2 months now after the mod and it has not fallen off ever since. Before that would happen almost daily.
