I printed them in a lovely marble filament, and my wife painted the nails with the "sluttiest" red nail polish she could find at the dollar store. Now this TV makes us smile even when it's not turned on.

Of course, the odds that these will be an exact fit for your TV are kind of low, but you can always scale these up or down in various dimensions to make them fit.
