### Summary

This spacer have been designed to disable the speed sensor on the rear wheel. This desactivate ABS for both wheels + TC

**Disclaimer : Use it at your own risk. Road regulation in your country probably forbid such a modification.**

By adding this spacer on the rear speed sensor, the bike isn't able to compute a difference of speed between the two wheels. Meaning that the ABS and Traction control remains disconnected.

Others informations

- You will have a dash error after a short ride. To remove it from the dash, you just have to make a short ride after removing this spacer.
- The ABS button will be yellow at any time.

- The Traction control button will be yellow at any time.
- You can remove the spacer, and reactivate the ABS + TC.
- The speed will then be only monitored by the front wheel.
- The speedometer will work and you will have your milleage / km stored on the bike as without the spacer

Cons :

- It use the oem torx, and you will need a tool to remove the spacer.  
Not good in a hurry.
