I needed basic counters for playing Magic The Gathering. These can be printed in the desired amount and by changing filament during printing, they can be multi coloured. I used black in the middle to make text easily visible, and then green for +x counters and red for -x counters. Red backsides can then be used to show for example "tapped next turn" etc.

## Print instructions

Variable layer height (.15 standard). Layer change at 1.1 and 2.15 mm. No brim, no supports. Printed with .4 mm PRusa i3 MK3.

They're just made quick and dirty in Tinkercad. There's some error in a couple of the files, but Prusaslicer fixes and slices just fine anyway so I didn't bother doing anything about it.

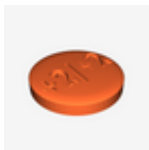
