He can - just like a Lizzard - easily loose his horns when you remove the support, thats why the normal Support is better.

But if you do not give up, he will finally sit bravely on your doorsteps and watch for the luck to enter your house.

I have added the files as i have printed it on my Bambu Lab X1 Printer.

For the supports i have used the "Bambu Support W" Filament in AMS-Slot 4, see picture.

Do not use the Tree-Support, use the Normal Support for this Model.

For the golden Filament in AMS-Slot 1, you can use **Gold PLA Filament** as the Support W will only work together with other PLA-Filaments.
