I used PrusaSlicer to set up the filament change. I printed this on my old school CR-10 so no fancy multicolour print here! :D

How I Designed This =====

I wanted to make something that could have a filament change to give contrast to the extruded letters. So I went for this simple design that could easily be printed on its back and then stand firmly when tilted.

Also, I wanted to print without using supports, but that's no problem with the angeled sides.

A pretty simple design process in Fusion 360. I used Adobe Illustrator to make the SVG files for the top.
