The tabs on mine broke so I measured and remodelled. The original model didn't use tape. Since the original model kept falling off I simply used duct tape to tape the printed one on.

Modelled in FUSION 360.

I printed with 100% infill as it is thin.

Requires no supports.

Printed in PLA.
