Wanted to free up space on my desk by mounting my soundbar. Screws into the lower two holes on the back of your monitor

Couldn't find any existing designs for my use case. I wanted to mount my soundbar to my LG widescreen monitor to free up desk space. sunny_raven has the only VESA mount I could find so I decided to build off of it.

Specific changes:

- Extended VESA mount to 7 inches (max on minis) to accommodate new mounts
- Designed simple shelf pieces to hold the soundbar

By no means perfect, but it works with my specific hardware:

I printed the mount itself with black PETG at 50% infill and the arms with PLA at 20%. No supports needed.
