I made this mask solid because I feel more immersed composing and not seeing the “uncropped” part of the image.

It is meant to just sit on the focusing screen and has grooves for both landscape and portrait if you would like to take vertical panos.

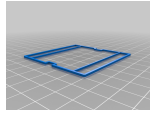
Best if printed in default ironing settings to get a smooth surface.

GCODE and 3MF sliced with the basic Prusa profiles.

I also included a film mask that sits in between the back and the body, on the body side so you can change the format on the same roll. Use at your own risk.

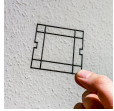
The accuracy of the crop will vary depending on your printer but on the film size it is exactly 56x20.68mm which is derived from the 65x24mm format.

Camera Hasselblad 6x45 Mask

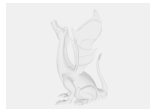

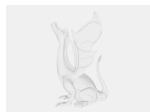
Phase One H20 / P20 digital back viewfinder mask for Hasselblad 500 V camera
