A sturdy keyboard tray to use with your shiny new Cintiq 27 Pro. (Use a bit of velcro to keep the keyboard from slipping)

Purchased a new Wacom Cintiq 27 Pro and don't feel like shelling out for the \$40 extension table add-on that Wacom should have provided with the unit in the first place?

3D printing to the rescue!

I printed this face down, PETG and around a 35% infill at .20 mm

The bolt will fit as shown, with some wiggling / fiddling.

I printed the bolt separately at 10mm detail using PETG and 100% infill for strength.

Attach the table into the vent grooves and guide the bolt into the threads. With some strength and tightening, you'll have a nice fit and a sturdy enough tray for a smallish Bluetooth keyboard. (I'm using the Logitech K810)
