A 40mm print fan mount for those using Rework 1.0 extruder.

- This fan mount is attached to the body extruder with the two M3 used to secure j-head/E3D hotend,a concept I've seen here before in thingiverse.

Notes:

I've printed this fan mount with ABS and FF coconut filament. While coconut/wood filament gives a very good (!) looking fan mount, ABS gives less weight, so I will recommend using ABS.

I didn't need supports, but I've integrated anyway at least for the base angle. You might need too for the screw holes in the sides (again, I didn't need to, but I didn't make supports for these this time) Notice in the pictures I don't use screws to attach the fan :

- I use ties, and I've been using rubber screws. I recommend them both.
