The Doomlings base set comes in a pretty big box. I thought I might be able to put everything in a neat box with dividers for the different card types in a smaller box, and here is the result

There are two boxes. The one pictured is the normal one.

The other one is an extended version that should be big enough to house the rule-pamphlet as well as the cards.

If you want to include the rule-pamphlet in the box, then print the ...extended versions of the box and lid. If you don't need that, then the normal box will suffice :)

The dividers are meant as such:

- A big compartment for all the traits
- One compartment for the life-cards and rule-cards

- One compartment for the ages-cards
- One compartment for the catastrophe-cards and the beginning of life-card
- The last compartment is meant for the rule-pamphlet.
 - This is the difference between the extended and “normal” box. The extended box has room for the rules to slide in and fold over the other cards. If you want to do that with the normal box, you have to cut away about 1.5cm on the sides on the pamphlet.
