Summary

These are small ergonomic pads that can be stuck (with double-sided tape) to the rear buttons on the steam deck

These provide a little bit of extra grip and actuation for the rear buttons by provided small ridges to rest your fingers against. For my large hands, I've spaced the ridges a little farther apart since my middle finger tends to sit high on L/R4 and my ring finger lower on L/R5.

Only provided the L4 and L5 model, to get R4 and R5 simply mirror in your slicing utility.

These print beautifully on their side with no supports on a resin printer, you may have to support a bit on FDM since they're a little skinny.
