No supports needed. For board plates, I would recommend changing the color in the middle of the print at the right height.

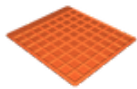
Other

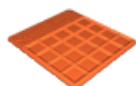

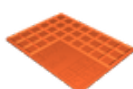

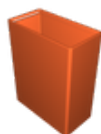
