A nice way to keep a few of your most important hex-shank bits secured together, either in your pocket or mounted.

Keep a few of your most important hex-shank bits secured together with this convenient little model. Each hole is just the right size to hold the bit snugly while still being easy to pull out when you need it.

Designed to be printed as the STL is oriented, and then the magnets can be pushed in (or with a slight tap from a hammer) after the print is finished. In our case, the magnets fit in tightly without requiring any glue.

You'll need 12 little magnets that are 4mm in diameter and 1.5 mm tall, such as [these](#).
