Notes:

I printed this without supports, which gave some messy bridging across the front of the chin bar. This is easy to remove and doesn't affect appearance.

It's a firm fit on the toilet roll holder's head and doesn't require glue.

How I Designed This

I had a low-poly OBJ or an original minifigure helmet. After assigning smoothing groups I used a mech-smooth modifier with 2 iterations. I then Boolean-subtracted a block from the back to match the target model, which also gives a good flat surface for the first layer.
