A sturdy and visible outdoor plant label

I wanted a sturdy label for my garden that would be highly visible and allow me to easily identify plants both by name, variety, and an inventory id.

These labels have held up over a couple of seasons, and are large enough for me to put a couple of lines of information on them without losing legibility.

Earlier models were a bit fragile, so I added a ridge for extra stability.

I printed mine in PETG, as PLA seems unlikely to last as well outdoors.

The files for this are blank, but you can easily add raised text through PrusaSlicer in whatever font/style you want. If you're printing at 100% scale, I'd suggest setting the depth of the text to 2-3mm from the surface.
