Adapter to keep automatic showers - typically found in public places like swimmingpools - active without activating

In Norway and quite possibly many other places, public showers as those in swimming pools and the likes, must be pushed every 30 seconds or so to keep the flow going. This is highly irritating, so I made this adapter to avoid it. To make it, just print the parts, two of "polykropp" and the dummy isn't needed - just in case you want to keep it all in one piece and show its function. Any plastic should work. If you print the dummy, you'd want some support, but apart from that, nothing else needed.
