Summary

Adjusting the back piece for Modular Glasses Display Stand from 137mm wide to 155mm wide.

The original Modular Glasses Display Stand had a 137mm-wide back piece for each pair of glasses (this is the piece that supports the stems of the glasses, the parts that would sit on your ears). This was too narrow for my glasses.

I expanded this total width to 155mm. Note that I kept the “lip” in place which does still define how wide the glasses can be “maximum” or “minimum” in a way, it's just now a larger space.

This fits my glasses well but I'm sure there are plenty of glasses larger than mine. I didn't want to make it too large where I didn't need it, but I could probably expand it again into an additional iteration for larger glasses.
