A little something I designed based on the same idea as the grocery lists a lot of people have made. holds a standard roll of plain paper. the turn wheel on the front advances the paper as things are checked off the list. I opted for a 1/8" piece of fiber board as the writing surface so as not to write overtop layer lines. I printed the parts first then marked and cut the board to size based on the printed model dimensions then glued everything together. It could be printed as 1 object if your bed is big enough or you trust standing it on end.

A note on the flat bars at the top ends. the gap is tight but it works better that way to hold the paper in place. Still, best to run a blade through the gap a few times to make sure everything will slide easily.

Also included in the files is the original 3mf to make remixing easier if you so choose.
