UPDATE:

My son managed somehow to destroy the box by let it falling down on hard ground.

So I redesigned a little bit and make it more stable by moving the rails 1,5mm more inside.

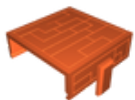

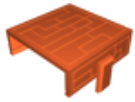
