Kia nameplate for the Harbor Freight Large Modular Toolbox, a roomier Frunk replacement for US RWD Kia EV6, Ioniq 5 .

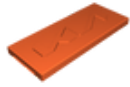

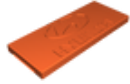
A few US owners have hacked their RWD Kia EV6 and Hyundai Ioniq 5 frunks by replacing the small OEM compartment with a roomier Harbor Freight Bauer Modular Toolbox. The Bauer nameplate on this toolbox can be popped out with a screwdriver, and replaced with these Kia or Hyundai versions, giving the hack a bit more OEM look. The Kia Logo is raised, to print these letters in a different color, though a filament swap is required. I printed this from PETG on a Prusa I3MK3S. (I have only tested this hack myself in an EV6.)
