Summary

A tension clip to hold wires between bricks on a wall. Designed for and used with christmas lights.

I wanted to run some Christmas lights on the flat surface of a brick wall at the front of my house. I looked for ways of fastening them and came up short with nothing but big bulky clips that were far too much for what I was looking to do.

So I hopped on tinkercad and threw together this little tension clip design that fits in the average gap between my bricks (which in my case was 11mm)

They are reasonably quick to print and I expect will fit the average brick gap, but you can scale it in your slicer to your requirements within reason. I think going much bigger or smaller might affect the flexibility/durability.

They seem to work for me!
