I am a fan of Lego minifigs, but not really a fan of the 4 stud baseplates traditionally used to stand minifigs on for display. So, to remedy this, I created a baseplate, but with 2 studs instead of the 'traditional' 4.

Also, I have recently discovered, these baseplates fit perfectly into the amazing [Lego Minifig Hexagons by Casadebricks.com](#) giving a sleek look, especially if printed in the same colour material.

Printed on a Prusa Mk3S, with a 0.4mm nozzle and layer height of 0.2mm in PLA. Please note, the tolerances on your printer may vary, so a little tweaking may be required.
