Incorporating both active and passive snow-clearing technology, this is the perfect gift for any car lover, or you may just want to print it for yourself.

Not only that, but when not in use, it can be stored on a festive tree to bring up to 87% more Christmas cheer.

Also, owing to the unique runic design incorporated into the flake, it prevents dragon attacks. Indeed, since I started carrying one around with me, I haven't even seen a dragon!

I printed mine with 10 walls for a strong print that still took under an hour and used only 6g of filament.

### Instructions:

**Active Ice Clearance** - Place your finger through the central spoke, take a firm grip, and rub the ice surface in a back-and-forth motion, shaving off thin pieces of ice until you are happy with the result.

**Passive Ice and Snow Clearance** - Simply print a few of these in black and scatter them on the icy surface. The sun will then warm them up, and they'll melt through the winter woes minutes faster than it would have otherwise cleared.

**Dragon Protection** - Keep one with you at all times to prevent attacks; this method is 100% foolproof.
