According to Wikipedia, "the ensō symbolizes absolute enlightenment, strength, elegance, the universe, and mu (the void). It is characterized by a minimalism born of Japanese aesthetics." This minimalist pendant is best printed in PLA or PETG, with 0.4mm nozzle and 0.15mm layers. The design of the pendant allows for easy attachment to a standard cord, or make your own kumihimo braided cord (as pictured)! The ensō circle pendant prints well in small and large sizes, and it can be embellished with a metallic marker (here, a gold marker was used).
