Tested and now seems to work good.

So, I did not find any good hammer holders out there - neither commercial nor DIY. But, Prusa to the rescue. And the quicksquare as well! Very useful while renovating my garage.

The hammer is fastened with a magnet - I use a 50mm by 20mm by 10mm neodymium. Sticks well.

The quicksquare is fastened with a twist hook.

Clips over pockets - back or front - possibly also on the belt, but I prefer them a bit lower.

Printed in PETG 0.3mm layers + 10° for better layer adhesion.
