### Summary

Simple floating shelf to support original Dyson wall mount. Requires 'floating' mounts

After I've mounted the Dyson as in the manual, I've noticed it is not comfortable to lift it up - it was too high. So I designed this simple shelf and mounted it inside a kitchen cabinet. The Dyson now can be simply pulled out towards the user. And you also clearly see the display when plugging it back in. The advantage of this is that you can mount attachments on the side of the main unit.

Attaching source file so you can adjust the holes position if your mount does not match.

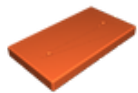

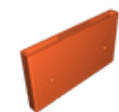
