
Cutlery Columns: Includes several sections for forks, table knives, spoons, and teaspoons, efficiently using the drawer space to maximize storage.

Utensil Area: Currently under development, this section is being designed to provide versatile storage options for various kitchen tools.


Compared to the previous IKEA insert, this design significantly increases storage capacity, allowing for the accommodation of a greater variety of
