I spent some time in Tinkercad.com designing this to be printed without supports. The lamp shade is made to fit an empty filament spool and might be a bit thick walled for some people, but i made it like that to be used with glow in the dark filament so when the light is turned off it makes a great nightlight.

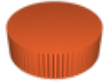
clear spool works best (from a previous lamp i made) for maximumlight. I used string light and wrapped it around the center of the spool so all the led lights are pointing outward towards the shade.
