Summary

Improve your posture when using an external keyboard by standing your Framework 13 vertically.

If your laptop folds open 180 degrees flat like the Framework 13 does, then you can significantly improve your workstation ergonomics by letting it stand vertically. This raises the screen closer to your eye level, reducing neck strain. This can also provide a better angle for the built-in webcam. This model is designed to fit exactly to the contour of the bottom edge of the Framework 13. It's sturdy enough to give you confidence that your laptop won't be knocked over, while still being extra compact and portable for on-the-go usage. Stands like this are even great in space-confined environments like airplane seats.

This is designed to be used along with an external keyboard and/or mouse. Note that using the built-in keyboard or trackpad while the laptop is vertical will negate all of the ergonomic benefits!
