### Summary

A quilting square ruler with 3-4-5-6-7-8 imperial inches marked, as well as 45 degree angles

My wife was looking for a very specific style quilting/quilt square rules and nothing seemed to cut it. We found a few different ones that were only about 50% of the way there so decided to start from scratch with what she wanted. The gaps marking the squares are large enough for pens, markers, or cutting wheels due to the chamfers. The diagonals are large enough for pens, but we opted to minimize the supports getting in the way of the squares, meaning the diagonals get cut more. If requested, I can move the supports into the squares to give the diagonals more play but it wasn't needed at the time she wanted this.

The squares are in imperial inches (we have a few things in Chinese inches so figured I should make this clear). The inner square is 3 inches and the outer is 8 inches. The middle of the slots are the true measurements. They are marked with debossed numbers.
