Anyway, this is the design of one of my favorite artifacts, so I thought it would be awesome to recreate it in CAD and print it in PLA. An homage to the ancestors!

The cookie cutter prints in about an hour and a half and doesn't require rafts or supports! In the picture, the design looks backward, but this is so it can create a pattern on your cookies that faces in the proper direction.
