Since one of the temples of my eyeglasses was broken, we designed a new one. The replacement temples are suitable for a screw system.

Unfortunately, I don't know which manufacturer this is. Maybe you're lucky and it fits your glasses?

Two-tone printing is particularly cool, but monochrome printing is also possible. Print it flat on your printbed, without raft or support, but not too fast.

After printing, the bending can easily be done individually with the help of a heat gun (or hair dryer ;-)).

Update: As a statement against the throwaway society, I have attached the Fusion file so that the temples can be individually adjusted.
