### Summary

This is a small M3 bolt that lets you plug unused threaded holes in your official Prusa enclosure.

Printed in PETG, 0.1mm with Prusament PETG.

The head fits the M3 Allen hex tool of the Prusa kit loosely.

The screw size is adjusted so that the metal threads of the enclosure just bite the screw threads. This way, when overtightening, the screw threads will break so that you have a lower risk of snapping the head of the screw off.

Still, be careful not to overtighten as the head of the screw may snap. They are plastic screws after all.
